REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- A completed application form downloadable at meu.edu.lb/admissions/apply (Please scan downloaded forms and send the filled in and signed forms as a PDF to admissions@meu.edu.lb)
- A passport-sized photo taken in the last six months.
- A clear photocopy of your identity card or passport.
- A clear photocopy of your family civil status record (for Lebanese nationals only)
- A document to certify your registration in Social Security (NSSF) (for Lebanese nationals only)
- English proficiency proof taken in the last two years (Please enclose one of the following when available):
 - Official scores of the TOEFL
 - Official scores of the IELTS
 - SAT I Writing Section
- Certified copies of all official high school certificates or diplomas.
- Two completed recommendation forms. The blank forms are included in this package, or downloadable at meu.edu.lb/admissions/apply
- Non-refundable application fee of:
 - LBP 50,000 for undergraduates
 - LBP 90,000 for graduates
- Official Lebanese Baccalaureate equivalency of non-Lebanese degrees (for Lebanese nationals only).

Additional Documents required for the Lebanese Freshman Program

- Permission from the Equivalence Committee of the Lebanese Ministry of Education to enroll in the Freshman Program.
- SAT I and SAT II with a minimum combined score of 2150 for Freshman Arts and 2350 for Freshman Science.
- Required subjects in the SAT II exam are:
 - Freshman Arts: Math I and any two other subjects.
 - Freshman Science: Math II and any two of the following subjects: Biology, Chemistry, or Physics.

Please note the following:

All Lebanese applicants must submit the SAT I and II scores prior to admission to their Freshman year.

TRANSFER APPLICANTS

- Applicants who have successfully completed one academic year or a minimum of 30 credits in a recognized institution of higher education may be exempt from entrance examinations.
- Applicants who have studied at other universities or colleges must submit official transcripts along with the corresponding academic catalogs of the respective university courses taken.
- Applicants will be required to sit for the MEU English proficiency exam if English was not the language of instruction.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Only completed applications will be evaluated.
- All required admission documents will become the property of MEU and must be submitted by the posted admission deadline.
- Fulfillment of the minimum admissions requirement does not guarantee admission.
- Andrews University applications are available.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

International students who have English as their mother tongue and have completed their high school degree in an English-speaking country, are exempt from providing scores or sitting for the EEE/TOEFL/IELTS exam.

Applicants must submit a certified copy of high school diploma and grades for 10th-12th grade. For US applicants, the diploma and grades must be authenticated by the school. For non-US applicants, the diploma and grades must be authenticated first by the Ministry of Education, then the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and lastly by the Lebanese Embassy in the applicant's home country.
